

THE 2023 CATHOLIC MINISTRIES DRIVE IS IN THE FINAL MONTHS: MAIL YOUR CONTRIBUTIONS DIRECTLY TO THE DIOCESE OF ALTOONA/JOHNSTOWN. St. Clare of Assisi has exceeded their goal. 38 families have contributed \$11,660.00 toward the target amount of \$9,983.00. \$1,657.00 has gone directly to the parish. At Resurrection Parish, 74 families have contributed \$19,130.00 towards the target amount of \$31,702.00.
