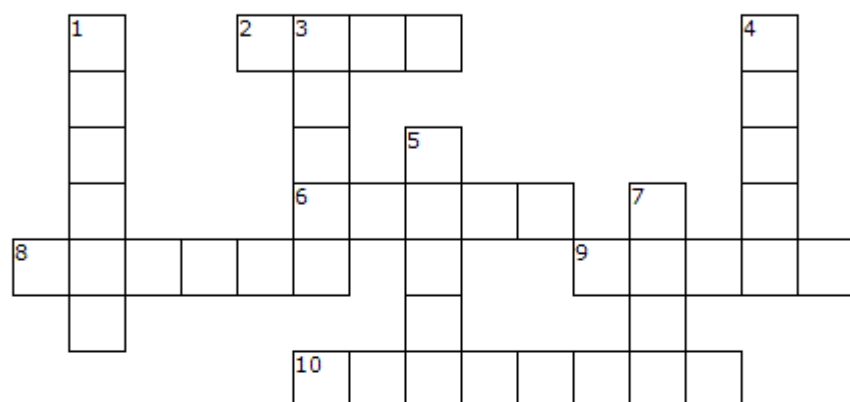

7. Thou shalt not commit adultery.



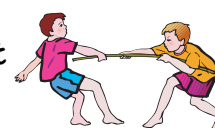

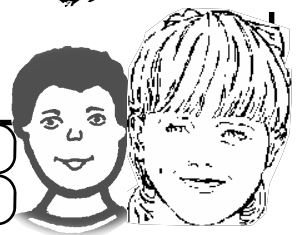
