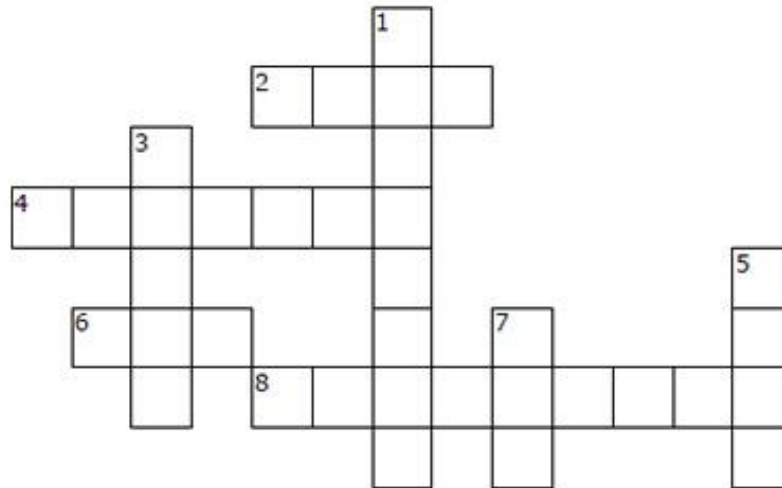

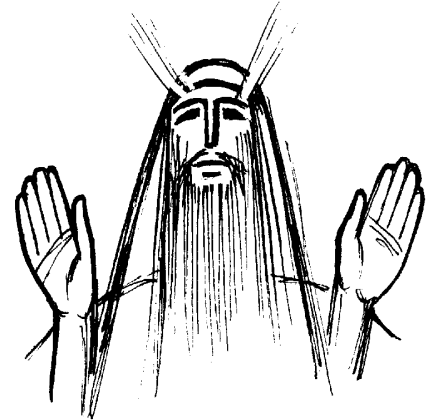


MOSES AND THE BURNING TREE

God spoke to Moses through a burning bush.

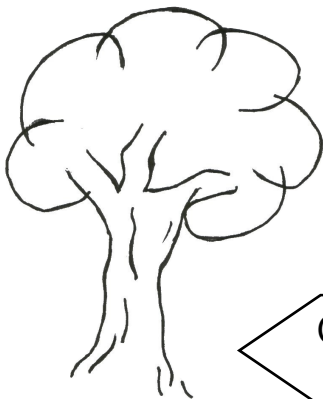
