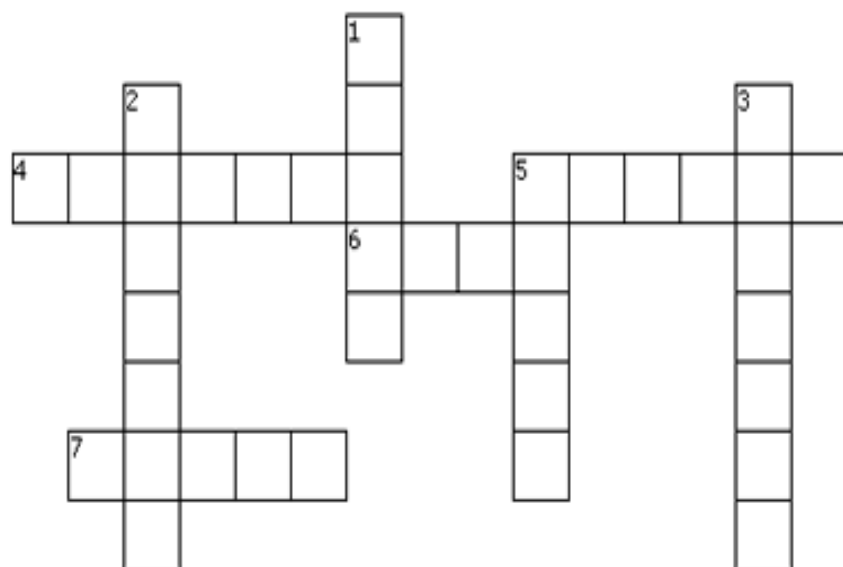

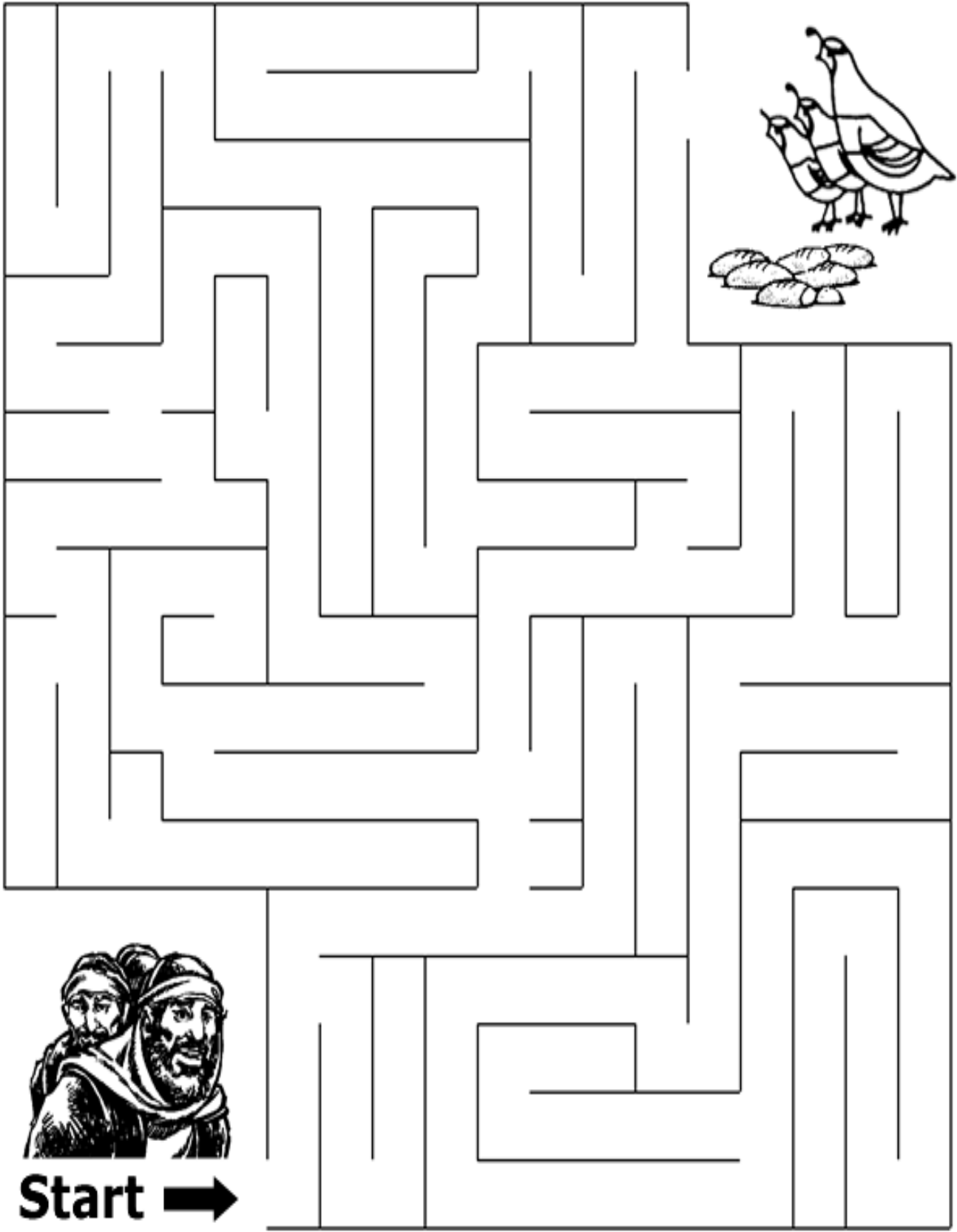

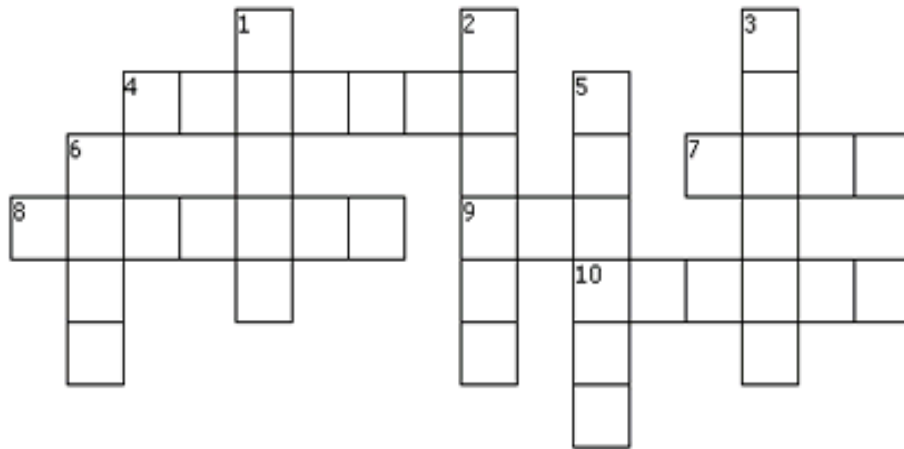




Dinner on the Ground

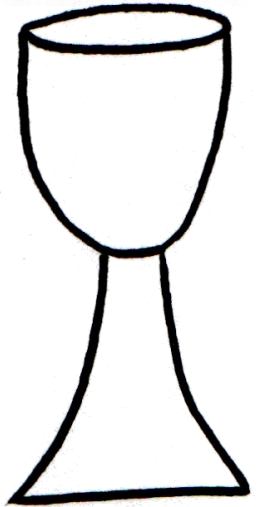
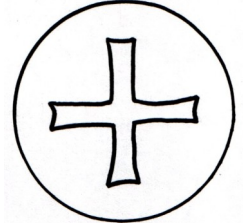
Year B — The Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)
