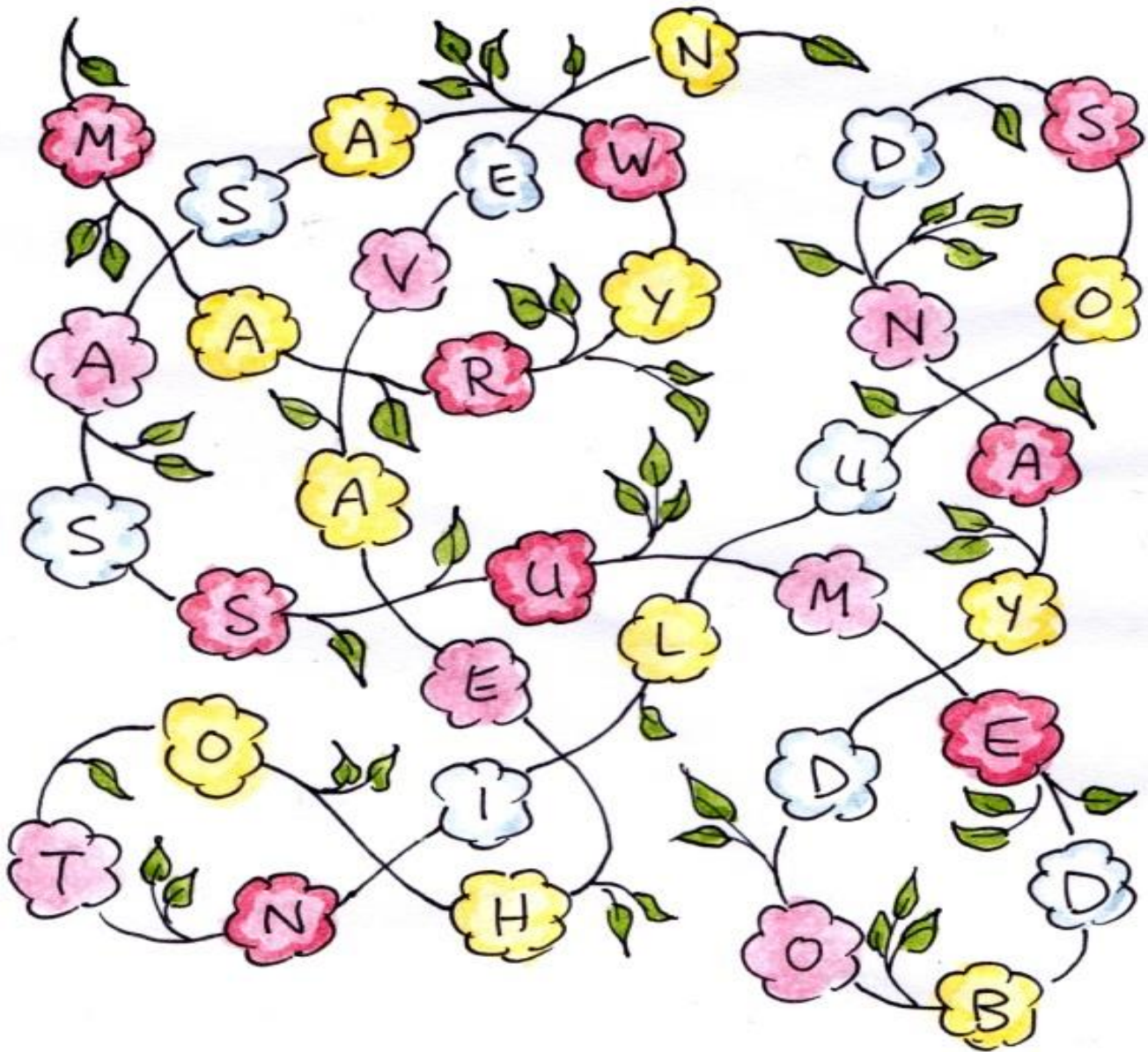

Follow the line of flowers, starting at the M, and use the letters in the flowers to fill in the blanks at the bottom of the page to find out what today's feast is about!

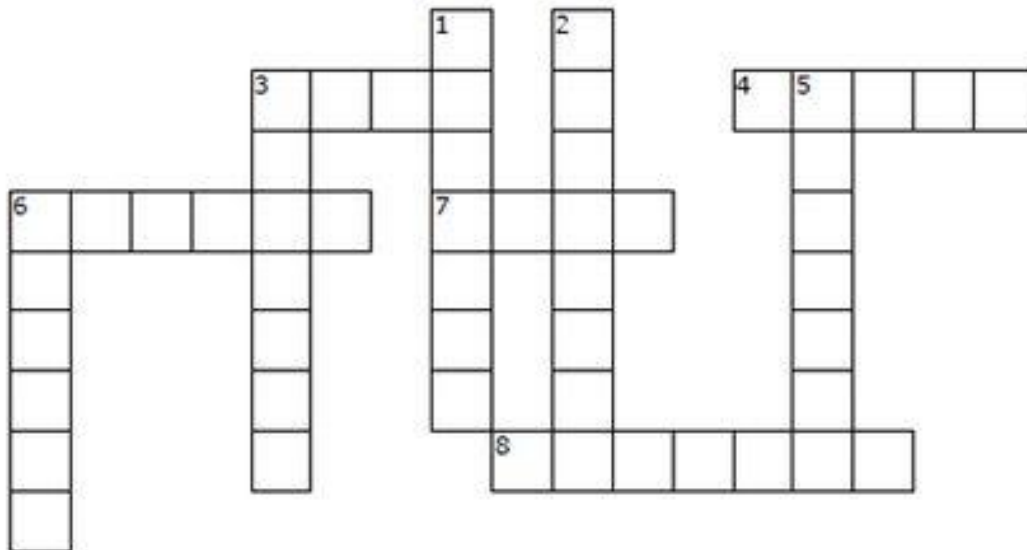

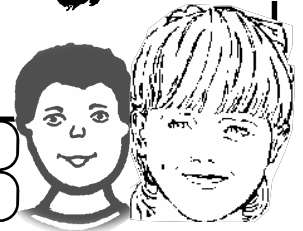

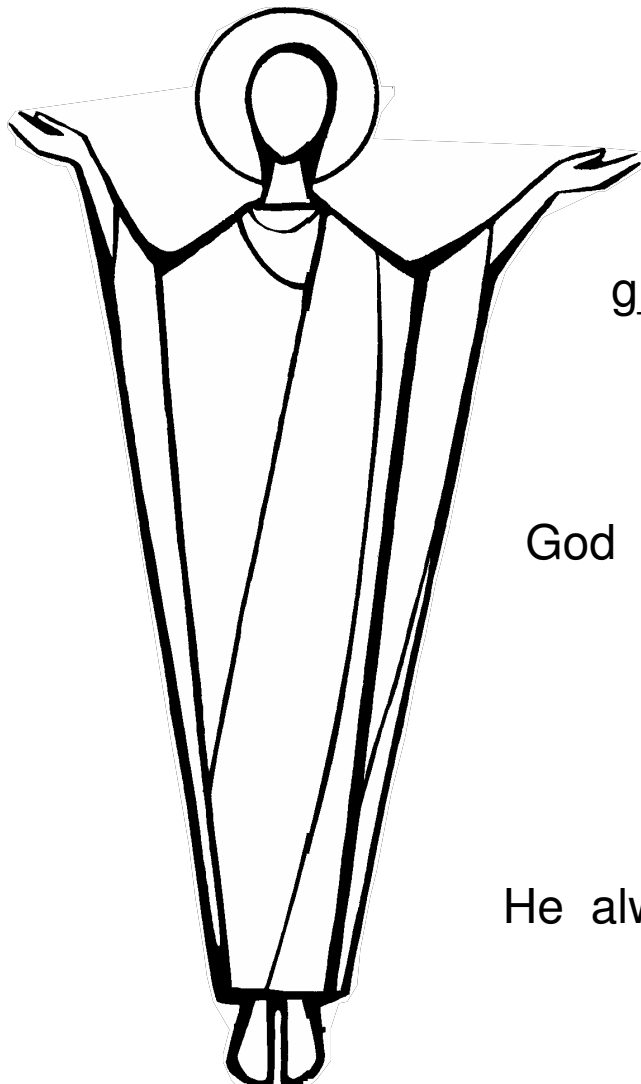
